

## **Turnberry Golf Club Code of Conduct**

The purpose of this code is to assist members and guests of Turnberry Golf Club to know and understand the standards of behaviour expected, and shall apply at all times when at Turnberry, or representing Turnberry Golf Club.

As a member of Turnberry Golf Club a certain standard of behaviour is expected which reflects the basic requirements of sportsmanship, integrity, courtesy and respect to be shown to all other members, visitors and members of Resort staff.

### **Code of Conduct**

- No member shall behave in a manner which might be considered by the committee of the Gentlemen's Section to be damaging to the reputation and standing of Turnberry Golf Club.
- Players shall dress in appropriate attire when in the clubhouse and on the courses
- Players shall treat fellow golfers with respect and refrain from using foul or abusive language or threatening behaviour.
- Play shall be continuous and without delay.
- Do not play until the match in front is out of range.
- Players searching for a ball should invite the game behind to play through as soon as it becomes apparent that the ball will not be easily found.
- If a match fails to keep its place on the course and loses more than one clear hole on the game in front, it should invite the match following to play through.
- Players are expected to respect the courses and their fellow golfers by repairing pitch marks, raking bunkers and replacing divots.
- Players shall respect the Greenkeeping staff on the course and not endanger them by playing into them.
- Members shall comply with the rules laid down by the clubhouse management while in the clubhouse. This includes complying with no smoking signs including e-cigarettes.
- Members shall not park in disabled parking bays unless in possession of the appropriate Blue Badge.
- Members are responsible for ensuring their guests comply with the code of conduct while on the course or in the Clubhouse.
